Dattajirao Kadam Arts, Science, Commerce College, Ichalkaranji was established in 1962. The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee year in 2012-13. The College is located in industrial city of Ichalkaranji well known as Manchester of Maharashtra. The total number of teaching & Non teaching staff is 33 permanent, 18 temporary & student teacher ratio is 31:1

The college is reaccredited with 'A' grade by NAAC with CGPA 3.02. During the last five years the college has tried its level best to comply with suggestions made by NAAC peer team during third cycle of accreditation. The college is recognized as one of the old & best colleges in university, not only in academics but also in the fields of sports, cultural and extension activities.

● **GENERAL RULES**

- 1) Admissions will be given as per State Govt, and University rules.
- 2) Repeaters are not admitted.
- 3) Marathi Medium for Arts faculty.
- 4) Marathi and English Medium for Commerce faculty.
- 5) English Medium for Science faculty.
- 6) Students in need of Transfer Certificates should apply in prescribed form along with T. C. fees.
- 7) It is mandatory for all students to attend all lectures, practicals, tests, tutorials and examinations. The Students not showing satisfactory performance shall lose the right for the admission for the next year. They will be penalized for the same.
- 8) Annual Social Gathering will not be held.
- 9) College Uniform is mandatory for all Students. The dress code of Salwar - Kameez - Dupatta is compulsory for girl students.
- 10) Use of Mobile Phone in College Campus and Classrooms is strictly prohibited.
- 11) The Government of Maharashtra has banned the ragging and notified ragging as a cognizable offence. The same will be followed in the college premises and hostel.
- 12) Students' four wheelers are not allowed in the college premises.
- 13) Parking rules for two wheelers are mandatory. The college has limited parking facility. The students may park on their own responsibility. 'No Vehicle Day' will be observed on every 2nd and 4th Saturday.
- 14) Change in subjects will not be allowed after 31<sup>st</sup> of August.
- 15) The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding in all matters.
- 16) Principal reserves the right to amend/modify rules.

● **RULES FOR ADMISSION**

- 1) The Principal reserves the right of admission.
- 2) The students seeking admission should submit the following documents with the application form.
  - i) School Leaving Certificate and Original Mark-Sheet of last examination passed along with two self attested Xerox copies thereof by the competent authority.
  - ii) Eligibility Certificate (Provisional / Final) in original from M.S.B.S. & H. S. E. Or Shivaji University, Kolhapur. (Only for students migrating from other states or Universities)
- 3) All admissions are valid only for one academic year subject to the satisfactory attendance and performances in Test, Terminal and Preliminary Examinations.
- 4) Students belonging to S.C./ S.T./ VJ./N.T./ O.B.C./ S.B.C./ wards of Ex-servicemen and physically handicapped should submit two self attested Xerox copies of their caste certificate and or the certificate which shall show the proof of the category. These students will be admitted as per the rules of Shivaji University, Kolhapur and Govt. Of Maharashtra.

● **FEE CONCESSION**

- 1) Students belonging to S.C./S.T./V.J./N.T./wards of Ex-servicemen/P.T.C./M.T.C./F.F./ & E.B.C. should submit the necessary documents at the time of admission for securing fee concession.

● **FREESHIP & SCHOLARSHIP**

**A) B. C. Freeship:**

The students eligible for B. C. Freeship should submit the application in prescribed form upto 31<sup>st</sup> Aug. along with the following documents.

- i) The Caste Certificate (Two attested Xerox copies)
- ii) Previous Exam. Mark-sheet (Two attested Xerox copies)
- iii) Income Certificate original (Copy of Tahasil Officer)
- iv) Adhar Card (One attested Xerox copy)  
(Income upto Rs. Six lakh for N.T, S.B.C., O.B.C.)
- v) Adhar Seeding slip (Self attested Xerox copy)

**B) Govt. of India Scholarship:**

The students applying for G.O.I scholarship should submit the duly filled scholarship form along with the following documents.

- i) The Caste Certificate (Two self-attested Xerox copies)
- ii) Previous Exam. Mark-sheet (Two self attested Xerox copies)
- iii) Adhar Card ( self attested Xerox copies)
- iv) Income Certificate original (One self attested Xerox copy) (Income upto Rs. One lakh for N. T. S. B. C., O. B. C. and income upto Rs. Two lakh for S. T. and S. C. students.)
- v) Adhar seeding slip (one self attached Xerox copy)
- 2) The students seeking concession in fees will be granted to economically backward class (E.B.C.) with annual income of less than Rs. 1,00,000/- must furnish income certificate of parents or guardian issued by the competent authority.

● **EBC SCHOLARSHIPS FOR OPEN CATEGORY:**

The students who want to avail EBC facility should fill up online forms in time. The students should fill up the forms on [www.ebc.dhemaharashtra.in](http://www.ebc.dhemaharashtra.in).

Following students shall be eligible for EBC.

- 1) The total earning of family should be up to 6,00,000/-(original copy of income certificate of Tahasildar)
- 2) The small norms applicable.
- 3) A copy of Adhar card and ration card must be attached.

The students of Non – Grant division are not eligible for EBC facility.

● **REFUND OF FEES AND DEPOSITS**

- 1) Only tuition fee and no other fees shall be refundable.
- 2) Tuition fees are refundable as under:
  - a) The entire amount paid by the student after deducting the 25% as administrative charges subject to following.
    - i) If a student gets his/her admission cancelled before the commencement of the academic term.
    - ii) If a student gets his/her admission to another college or institution having courses which are different from those in this college to which he/she had first sought admission and paid tuition fee provided that he / she has informed the principal of this college well in time (three weeks after the commencement of the academic year) about his/her application for admission to the another institution.

The application for refund in such cases must be forwarded through the head of the institution where the student actually joins; giving details

of such course selected by him/her and the date of his/her application to the concerned institution.

- b) 50% of the amount paid by a student as tuition fee, if he / she applies for cancellation of his / her admission and the refund of fee before the last date of admission in the institution fixed by the university.
- c) A student shall not be entitled to claim refund of tuition fee if he / she leaves the college after the last date of admission.
- d) In case of a student who fails to inform the Principal of the college about his / her intention to leave or change the college, full fees for the term or the year, as the case will be charged.
- 3) The amount of caution money, Library deposit, Laboratory deposit etc. shall be refundable with deductions as necessary on account of any damage to the property of the institution such as breakages to laboratory equipments, loss of library books etc. for which a student may be responsible.
- 4) The applications for refund of such deposit shall be made within six months either from the date he /she leaves the college or completes the course and the college shall refund the amount within 30 days from the date of receipt of application. The student must submit the receipt of fees paid to claim refund of deposits.

● **DISCIPLINE :**

All the students must abide rules and regulations of the college. Students shall not do anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image.

No political or any other kind of influence should be brought to the college directly or indirectly.

● **CODE OF CONDUCT :**

Students should always carry their Valid College Identity Card around the neck before they enter the college campus. During the conduct of lectures students should not loiter in and around the college premises. While representing the college at any other place the students' behaviour should not be detrimental and injurious to the image of the college.

In case of any problem concerned with the college, students should contact the Principal or the Registrar of the college.

● **ATTENDANCE**

- i) The minimum attendance of 75% of the students for theory, practical and tutorials is compulsory, failing which their terms will not be granted and such students will not be allowed to appear for the Annual Examination.
- ii) The student who fails to maintain the minimum attendance on account of illness, or any other reason which is deemed fit by the Principal should apply in writing to the Principal for leave of absence, prior or within two days from the date of commencement of such leave, failing which he/she will be treated as defaulter.

iii) All applications for leave of absence along with medical certificate should be submitted to the college office.

● **RAGGING PREVENTION COMMITTEE:**

Ragging prevention committee is formed in the college and it solves. The complaint regarding ragging.

- 17) repeaters seeking admission to higher class should produce the admission receipt and renew their identity cards in College Library.

- 19) As per Govt of Maharashtra circular dt. 22-5-2015 every student should write their Adhar card number (UID), Nationalized Bank account number and name of the Bank in the admission form.

**ADMISSION CRITERIA**

- 1) Students who have passed H. S. C. / XII<sup>th</sup> Std. examination of the M. S. B. S. and H. S. E., Pune are eligible for admission to the first year of the degree college (First year B. A. / B. Sc./ B. Com/ B. C. A.) in the stream in which he/she has passed the H.S.C. Examination.
- 2) Students who have passed H. S. C. (XII<sup>th</sup> Std.) examination conducted by any other statutory Board in India are eligible for admission to F. Y. B. A. / B. Sc. / B. Com. / B. C. A class provided they produce provisional and eligibility certificate obtained from Shivaji University, Kolhapur. However, final eligibility and migration certificates from previous Board attended should be submitted to the college before the end of the first term.
- 3) The eligibility rules framed by Shivaji University, Kolhapur are applicable for admission to First year B.A./B. Sc./B. Com./B.C.A. class.

**UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING  
IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009**

● **Objectives :**

To root out ragging in all its forms from universities, colleges and other educational institutions in the country by prohibiting it by law, preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of these regulation punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and appropriate law in force.

● **Definition of Ragging :**

**"Ragging" Means :**

Any conduct whether by words, spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course & which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

● **Punishable ingredients of Ragging:**

Abetment to Ragging, criminal conspiracy to rag, unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging, public nuisance created during ragging, violation of decency and morals through ragging. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, use of criminal force, assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences, extortion, criminal trespass, offences against property, criminal intimidation, attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s), physical or psychological humiliation, all other offences from the definition of "Ragging"

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that the University authorities have granted approval to fee structure of B.Sc. Computer Science . The fee structure for the course is mentioned below:

- 1) a) B.Sc. Part-I Computer Science Tuition Fee Rs. 12,000 /- (per year)
- b) B.Sc. Part-II Computer Science Tuition Fee - Rs. 14,500 /- (per year)
- c) B.Sc. Part-III Computer Science Tuition Fee - Rs. 17,500 /- (per year)
- 2) Other fee shall be charged as per University rules which include admission fee, gymkhana fee, library fee, Vikas Nidhi, etc.
- 3) The suggested fee should be revised after every three years. If not revised, 10 % increase in the tuition fee per three years is recommended.
- 4) Above mentioned fee shall come into effect from academic year 2013-14
