Report of Public Session on

'Social Movements of Denotified and Nomadic Tribes'

Jointly organized by Departments of Sociology, St. Mira's College for Girls, Pune and Dattajirao Kadam College, Ichalkaranji

A joint public lecture was hosted by the Sociology Department St Mira's College for Girls, Pune in collaboration with Dattajirao Kadam Arts, Science and Commerce College Ichalkaranji. Dr. Arjun Jadhav who is the Head of Sociology Department at Dattajirao-Kadam College was the Guest Speaker for the day. The program was held on Friday 24th September 2021 from 11 am to 1 pm. The session was conducted bilingually in Hindi and Marathi. 75 participants including faculty and students from Maharashtra attended the session.

Primarily, a brief introduction was done by Vaishali Joshi Ma'am which shed some light on the details of the academic collaboration between the two institutions. This was followed by the introduction of the esteemed speaker by Nivritti - A student from Sociology Special at St. Mira's. This included the mention of various achievements and areas of interest of the dignitary.

The topic was introduced by Dr. Jadhav by posing a question about the true meaning of freedom and independence to the audience.

The concept of Denotified Tribes was then explained in detail to the students. Dr. Jadhav gave many diverse examples about the existence of different tribes and their occupations. Coming towards the main focus of the lecture, the guest speaker informed the Students about the laws enacted in the British era which notified many tribes as criminals. Later the details of the post independence law that came into force in 1953 were shared with the listeners. This particular law decriminalized or Denotified these tribes.

He later meticulously described about the settlements for these denotified tribes that were functional. The layers of the settlements were subject to the amount of criminal activities of the community. The doors of these settlements were opened only in the year 1960. Thus, their concept of freedom was still left unattainable after the whole country was set free. The current status of these tribes were also thrown light upon by the speaker. What attracted focus was the gravity of their problems. They still struggle against economic, social problems. They have been facing educational backwardness and have almost negligible political representation.

Because of being away from civil life, superstitions are still prevalent here. They are victims to poor health facilities and high rate of addiction.

He informed about movements through literature to mobilize the masses and make them aware of these problems. What is needed is for everyone to accept them into mainstream society is what was focused upon. The session was then ended with a wonderful insight into what common public can do to improve the condition of the Denotified Tribes and how they can be made an undetachable section of the country.

This was followed upon by a very enriching question answer session wherein the doubts of the audiences were adhered to. The extremely inspiring event ended with a formal vote of thanks.
