facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the problem of :

- i. Innovations in education leading to restructuring of courses, new methods of teaching and learning and integral development of personality.
- ii. Studies in various disciplines
- iii. Inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary studies
- iv. National integration, secularism and international understanding.

**NOW THEREFORE THE D.K.A.S.C.COLLEGE, ICHALKARANJI
AND
AMBIKA NURSERY, ICHALKARANJI (SANGLI ROAD)**

1. FIELD OF COOPERATION:

2. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS/TEACHERS:

Teachers, research guides and students of both the institutions shall be encouraged to work in tandem in the laboratories, workshops, faculties and departments of both the institutions.

B. Issues relating to travel, boarding, lodging, miscellaneous expenses shall be incorporated in this Para and shall vary according to the rules, regulations and policies of every institution.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. The details for the efficacious implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.

b. The parties to this memorandum may, be mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this agreement.

c. The intent and implementation of this memorandum is SUBJECT to the policies of the respective states (in case of international agreements) and the laws of land.

d. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of 5 years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalization and accomplishment thereof.

e. The parties to this MOU undertake to treat as **CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED** information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.

f. This MOU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions.

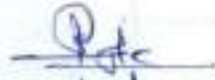

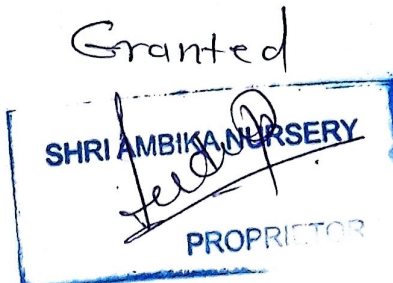

Nursery Visit Report
B. Sc. III (2022-2023)

Study tours or field visits are arranged to provide students an experience outside the classroom and laboratory. It is helpful for clearing the concepts and results in learning that is more effective. It also develop an understanding of students towards surroundings.

By knowing the importance of field visits and study tours, our department was arranged one-day visit to Shri Ambika Nursery Sangli phata, Ichalkranji and Sahyadri Biotech nursery, Wathar on dated 22/04/2022. The visit places selected as per the syllabus for us.

1. Shri Ambika Nursery, Ichalkaranji

It is well-known nursery in Ichalkaranji and surrounding spread about in 3000 sq. ft. area. Aim of Shri Ambika nursery to produce healthy plants and their supply. This plays important role in creating interest in plantation as well as conservation of biodiversity. It is well-established nursery having all types of plants. They provides plantlets of various ornamental and fruit yielding plants.

Tree section:

Variety of flowering and fruiting trees are grown and maintained at nursery. Trees grown from seeds or vegetative propagation. Some of those are *Syzygium* sp., *Magnolia champaca*, different varieties of *Mangifera indica*, *Manilkara zapota*, *Conocarpus* etc.



Indoor plants:

Several beautiful indoor plants were seen in nursery. Most of indoor plants grown in polyhouse to maintain climatic conditions. Hanging baskets were prepared for indoor climbing species e.g. *Pothos* varieties, fern species, *Portulaca* varieties, *Verbena* sp., *Calocasia* sp., *Curio radicans*, Orchids, *Fittonia* sp., *Anthurium*, *Dracena* (Lucky bamboo) etc.

Outdoor Plants:

This section includes specially woody and bushy plants along with these some herbaceous plants and climbers that require maximum sunlight. These are *Thuja*, *Bouganvillea*, *Melastoma*, *Plumeria* sp., *Piper* sp., *Ipomoea indica*, *Combretum*, *Pelargonium* sp., *Difenbachia*, *Conocarpus* different palms etc.

Hydrophytes:

Aquatic plants also add beauty in garden. Different water lilies *Nymphaea* are cultivated in this nursery. Pteridophytic plant *Equisetum* that used as ornamental also grown in nursery.


Succulents:

These are most attractive ornamental plants. They can be used as indoors as well as outdoors. They requires less water and minimum care hence they are more popular. Some produce flowers, some have beautiful leathery leaves, spiny succulents also present in this nursery. Names of succulents are *Opuntia*, *Echeveria*, *Crassula*, *Adenium*, different Sedums etc.

Topiary:

It is attractive part of this nursery. Art of giving different shapes to plants is known as topiary. In this nursery *Malphigea* and jade plants used for topiary. Topiaries of different shapes such as turtle, elephant, and heart are developed.
