Common Name: Tagar, pinwheel flower

General Characters:

- Tagar flowers are native to India and Southeast Asia, and they have been cultivated for their beauty and medicinal properties for centuries.
- Tagar has traditionally been used to manage intestinal spasms, nervous stomach (digestion influenced by the stomach), and colic (severe abdominal pain, usually in babies).
- Tagar has a bitter flavour that may help with digestion and appetite. It may also be used as a carminative or a gas-relieving agent.
