Botanical Name: *Chamaecostus cuspidatus* (Nees & Mart.) C. Specht & D. W. Stev

Family: Costaceae.

Common Name: Insulin plant, Costus, spiral flag

General Characters:

- Leafy shoots 1.5-2.5 m tall.
- Leaves spirally arranged on the stem.
- Leaves are light green in color.
- *Costus* is spreading plant reaching about two feet tall.
- *Costus* are bitter in taste with strong aromatic odor.
- *Costus* roots contains chemicals that might kill parasite.
- *Costus* slow down activity in the intestines.
