Botanical Name: Hamelia ptens Jacq.

Family: Rubiaceae.

Common Name: Firebush, Hummingbird bush, Scarlet bush, and redhead.

Origin: American subtropics and tropics, Southern United States, Argentina.

Characters:

- This plant is free-flowering.
- The flowers are arranged in cymes, clusters of flowers that occur at the end of forking floral stalks.
- Each flowers has small and triangular lobes on a narrow tube with swollen base.
- They are popular as ornamental plants.
- They are used in landscaping and as street trees.
- *Hamelia* attracts pollinators such as hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees.
- Hamelia patens is an ornamental plant grown almost worldwide in warm,
 moist areas.
- *Hamelia* used to treat athletes foot, skin lesions and insect bites, nervous shock, inflammation, rheumatism, headache, asthma, and dysentery.
